** COMPETITION INFORMATION **

RULES/CONDUCT/ELIGIBILITY (USFSA events)

The South Florida Challenge is open to all qualified eligible skaters who are members in good standing of the USFS and their Home Club. Each skater may compete in as many events as qualified by their test level as of March 1, or one level higher, *but not both*. For all age requirements, the age required is the age of the individual as of March 1. Unless otherwise noted, age requirements are in accordance to the USFS rulebook. All efforts will be made to split competitors by age. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules set forth in the current edition of the USFSA Rulebook.

RULES/CONDUCT/ELIGIBILITY (Basic Skills events)

The South Florida Challenge is open to all skaters who are eligible (ER1.00) members of either the Basic Skills Program and/or are full members of U.S. Figure Skating. To be eligible, skaters must have submitted a membership application or be a member in good standing. Members of other organizations are eligible to compete but must be registered with the host Basic Skills Program/club or any other Basic Skills Program/club. Eligibility will be based on skill level as of the closing date of entries, March 1st. All Snowplow Sam and Basic Skills 1-8 skaters must skate at their highest level passed or one level higher and NO official U.S. Figure Skating tests may have been passed including MIF or individual dances.

It is very important to the success of the competition that skaters are placed in the correct divisions. If for whatever reason, the LOC discovers that a skater has been placed in a category below their class level, the chairman and referee will have the option to move the skater into the proper division even if this has to be done the day of the competition. This will ensure that every event is as fair as possible to the competitors. Please be sure to check for the director/instructor's signature confirming the level of the skater.

If there is only one competitor entered in a Basic Skills event, the referee will give the skater the option to compete. If the competitor chooses to compete, they will be awarded their marks in the 6.0 system, and the competitor will receive first place. If they choose not to compete, the entry fee will be refunded.

ENTRIES

Entries must be submitted on-line through Entryeeze by Tuesday, March 1, 2012. Visit www.panthersfsc.com for registration link and additional competition information. Entry Fees must be paid online via Entryeeze. **The entry fee is \$120.00 for the first IJS USFS event and \$70.00 for each additional IJS event** (Singles and Pairs Free Skate and Short Programs Juvenile thru Senior Levels). **\$90.00 for the first Non IJS event entered and \$45.00 for each additional Non IJS event.** All entries submitted after March 1, 2012 will be considered late entries. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee, and will be charged a one time late fee of \$35.00 per application.

Planned Program Content Form

If you are registering for an IJS event, you are required to complete the Planned Program Element form online at <http://www.usfigureskating.org> by March 15, 2012. This form can be found in the Members Only section of the US figure skating website.

CRITIQUES

Individual critiques will be offered if time permits, for the short and Free Skate programs of Juvenile through senior skaters. Critiques will be open only to skaters and their coaches. Upon arrival, please sign-up for critiques at the registration desk at least one hour prior to your event.

MUSIC

Only CD will be accepted. The medium must be clearly labeled with the skater's name and event on the side that is to be played. All CDs must be prepared by the skater and contain only the skater's program. Commercial CDs with multiple programs will not be accepted. Every reasonable care will be taken, but the Panthers FSC will not be responsible for damaged, lost or broken CD's. Each competitor is responsible for delivery of their music to the Registration Desk at the time of registration and for pickup from the Registration Desk at the conclusion of each event. Once the music is registered, it will not be returned until after the event has been skated.

An extra copy of the competitor's music should be readily available at all times.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded for first through fourth placements in each scheduled South Florida Challenge event category.

REGISTRATION

A Registration Desk will be at *Saveology Iceplex* during the scheduled practice times and events. Skaters are required to check the official bulletin board located at the rink for official practice times and the scheduled events. Posting of such notices or changes shall be considered sufficient notice to competitors. Skaters and coaches should arrive at least 1 hour before their scheduled competition time. All schedules will also be posted on the Entryeze System.

PRACTICE ICE

Practice ice registration will be announced on the Panthers Figure Skating Club website www.panthersfsc.com after the close of entries and will be available for purchase only through the Entryeze system. Each skater will be eligible to purchase two (2) practice ice sessions per event entered. Additional practice ice may become available after the initial practice ice registration.

VIDEO

Individual videotaping will be permitted in designated areas ONLY. Professional video taping of each event will be available. Except for the official video producer, **only battery-operated cameras will be permitted with NO tripods. NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY, PLEASE!**

Qualifications for Compulsory Moves are the same as stated in the Free Skate Section. Compulsory Moves will be skated without music and without stopping between elements. Elements may be performed in any order but performed only once. Only listed elements may be performed; additional elements or repetition of failed elements will be penalized. Spin revolutions indicated are minimums. No turn or change of foot allowed in jump combinations. An axel is considered a single jump. Unless indicated, connecting steps may be incorporated but will not be judged.

All Compulsory moves will be skated on half ice. *Juvenile & Open Juvenile on full ice.

Combination jumps must be performed with no turn or change of foot between jumps. The jump combination may consist of the same jump or another jump (single, double, and triple as prescribed). However, the jumps included must be different from the solo jumps unless otherwise stated. Skaters will be given only **one** opportunity to perform each jump.

COMPETITIVE TEST TRACK EVENTS

Competitors will skate to music of their choice, vocal music permitted. The 6.0 judging system will be used for all Test Track events.

Deductions **WILL** be made for skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description.

- 0.1 from EACH mark for each technical element included that is not permitted in the event description.
- 0.2 from the technical mark for each extra element.
- 0.1 for any spin with less than required revolutions.
