**** COMPETITION INFORMATION ****

RULES/CONDUCT/ELIGIBILITY (USFSA events)

The South Florida Challenge is open to all qualified eligible skaters who are members in good standing of the USFS and their Home Club. Each skater may compete in as many events as qualified by their test level as of February 15, or one level higher. For all age requirements, the age required is the age of the individual as of February 15. Unless otherwise noted, age requirements are as follows: Juvenile 12 and under, Open Juvenile 13 to 24, Intermediate 17 and under, Open Intermediate 18 to 24, all Adult events 25 and over. All efforts will be made to split competitors by age. Skaters entering any USFS event **cannot** enter any Special event. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules set forth in the current edition of the USFSA Rulebook.

RULES/CONDUCT/ELIGIBILITY (Special events)

The South Florida Challenge is offering Special Free Skate events. The purpose of these events is to promote a fun introduction to the competitive sport of figure skating. Skaters must be a member of either USFS Basic Skills or the ISI. Skaters, who have passed any USFSA tests beyond Basic Skills, are **not** eligible to compete in the Special Free Skates. Skaters, who have passed any ISI tests beyond Freestyle 4, are **not** eligible to compete in the Special Free Skates. Judging will be based on carriage, speed, flow, and sureness of edge, stroking technique, jump and spin technique, and music expression. Special Free Skate competitors will be allowed to enter the Special Showcase event. Skaters entering any Special event **cannot** enter any USFS event.

ENTRIES

The entry fee is \$100.00 for the first IJS USFS event and \$60.00 for each additional IJS event. Fees must accompany the completed application. (Singles and Pairs Free Skate and Short Programs-Juvenile thru Senior Levels)

\$85.00 for the first Non-IJS event entered and \$45.00 for each additional Non-IJS event. (No test Free Skate, Compulsory Moves, Jumps, Spins, Solo Dance, Partner Dance, Adults and Test Track.)

Entries must be postmarked no later than midnight February, 15, 2010. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee and will require a late fee of \$25.00. Once entries have closed, entry fees are only refundable if the competition is not held. The Panthers FSC reserves the right to divide or combine any event(s). An alternate schedule will be posted on the web sites: www.incredibleice.com and www.floridaskating.com, as soon as possible after the close of the entries.

Please review your choice of events closely. Any change of event, as a result of **your mistake**, will result in a \$25.00 processing fee for each event changed. **Please fill your forms out correctly and check with your instructor.** There will be a \$35.00 charge for any returned checks.

Planned Program Content Form

If you are registering for an IJS event, you are required to complete the Planned Program Element form on line at <http://www.usfigureskating.org> by February 26, 2010. This form can be found in the Members Only section of the US figure skating website.

CRITIQUES

Individual critiques will be offered if time permits, for the short and Free Skate programs of Juvenile through senior skaters. Critiques will be open only to skaters and their coaches. Upon arrival, please sign-up for critiques at the registration desk at least one hour prior to your event.

All events and practices will be held at ***incredible ICE***, 3299 Sportsplex Dr., Coral Springs, Fl. 33065, (954)341-9956. ***incredible ICE*** is a state-of-the-art, Ice Skating and Entertainment Facility, featuring three official NHL size rinks, each 85' x185'. ***incredible ICE*** is the proud home of the NHL Florida Panthers. ***incredible ICE*** is a complete facility with an Off-ice Training Center, Breakaway Bar & Grill and ***incredible SPORTS*** Pro shop for all your skating needs.

MUSIC

Only CD will be accepted. **No Cassette tapes.** The medium must be clearly labeled with the skater's name and event on the side that is to be played. All CDs must be prepared by the skater and contain only the skater's program. Commercial CDs with multiple programs will not be accepted. Every reasonable care will be taken, but the Panthers FSC will not be responsible for damaged, lost or broken CD's. Each competitor is responsible for delivery of their music to the Registration Desk at the time of registration and for pickup from the Registration Desk at the conclusion of each event. Once the music is registered, it will not be returned until after the event has been skated.

An extra copy of the competitor's music should be readily available at all times.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded for first through fourth placements in each scheduled South Florida Challenge event category. Special Free Skate events will be awarded medals for first through fourth placements and ribbons for all others.

REGISTRATION

A Registration Desk will be at ***incredible ICE*** during the scheduled practice times and events. Skaters are required to check the official bulletin board located at the rink for official practice times and the scheduled events. Posting of such notices or changes shall be considered sufficient notice to competitors. Skaters and coaches should arrive at least 1 hour before their scheduled competition time.

PRACTICE ICE

A practice ice schedule will be determined upon the close of entries. A practice ice form and schedule will be mailed to all competitors who include a self-addressed, stamped envelope. All forms and schedules will be posted at www.incredibleice.com and www.floridaskating.com as soon as they're available.

VIDEO

Individual videotaping will be permitted in designated areas ONLY. Professional video taping of each event will be available. Except for the official video producer, **only battery-operated cameras will be permitted with NO tripods. NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY, PLEASE!**

Qualifications for Jumps are the same as stated in the Free Skate Section. **Pre-Preliminary through juvenile, open juvenile and all adult levels will skate on half ice.** Jumps may be performed in any order. Combination jumps must be performed with no turn or change of foot between jumps. The jump combination may consist of the same jump or another jump (single, double, and triple as prescribed). However, the jumps included must be different from the solo jumps unless otherwise stated. Skaters will be given only **one** opportunity to perform each jump.

Only the required elements will be judged in Free Skate 1-3. Skating order of the required elements is optional. Minimum number of connecting steps allowed. Elements are not restricted as to number of times elements are executed, length of glides or number of turns in spins unless otherwise stated. Program to be skated on full ice surface with music. Vocal or instrumental music is allowed. May use elements from a previous level, but not a higher level than event entered. Deductions will be made if elements from a higher level are skated. Events will be split by appropriate age & level.

Ladies, men, mixed pairs, and like pairs can enter the showcase events. Competitors will be judged on technical merit, costume (its suitability to the music), music interpretation, choreography (suitability of the program sequence and elements to the music), and audience appeal (overall compositions, appearance and style). Live props are not permitted. Props may not be flame or smoke oriented or any other substance that will alter the ice surface.



Competitive Test Track

Skaters may enter **EITHER** the Competitive Test Track or the “Well Balanced Free Skate” but **NOT** both. Competitors will skate to the music of their choice. Deductions **WILL** be made for the skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description. All times are +/-10 seconds.
